# Benefits of Using Comments



## Clarity

Comments make your code more understandable, especially for others reading your code or for you when you revisit it later.



## Maintainability

Comments help you maintain your code, making it easier to make changes and fix bugs.



## Debugging

Comments can help you debug your code by temporarily disabling parts to isolate issues.

# What are Comments?

Comments explain your code, making it more readable. They help others understand your logic and intentions.

Comments can also be used to temporarily "disable" parts of your code during testing or debugging. You can comment out a line of code to see what happens without the code executing.
